



Contents show] History and development AutoCAD was originally developed in 1982 by Paul Tarrant at the then-called the Autodesk company. In 1983, it was acquired by Autodesk and was marketed and sold as a package for microcomputers with built-in graphics cards or graphics hardware. In March 1984, the DOS version was released, and in February 1985, the first version for the Apple Macintosh (the Mac 1, commonly referred to as the Macintosh) was released. Although it was first available on the Macintosh, an early version of the software was also available for the IBM PC. Worked as a separate application and the "drawing" commands could be invoked directly from the command line and the corresponding output could be saved to disk. In the early days, AutoCAD did not provide any undo capability. The command interface was implemented in C and used static text-based displays. However, the command set was static. It was not possible to create new commands to extend the user interface, or to add new capabilities. All changes were done by the developers. The interface was non-interactive and command-driven. In 1985, the first version of AutoCAD became multi-user and able to run on a single machine. In 1985, the command set of the program was extended. The user interface was also changed, and non-interactive commands were added. In 1987, the first version for Windows was released. AutoCAD did not offer a true 3D modeler but relied on the graphics capabilities of the local computer. AutoCAD's early 3D capabilities were based on the use of AutoCAD's 2D planes as the base layer. The first built-in 3D solids capability came in AutoCAD 2.4. In the late 1980s, AutoCAD began to gain market share against DRAW, which was a legacy product released by the founder of Autodesk. It was also popular because it provided the ability to run on any platform. In 1988, the Windows version was released for the 386 processor class, and in 1992, the first version for Microsoft Windows 95 was released. AutoCAD 2000 was the first product that introduced native 3D modeling. In 1993, a version for Windows NT was released. At the time, the NT platform was not well suited for AutoCAD and so Microsoft chose not to support it.

Beyond the physical sheet, information on software and hardware can be accessed and modified. This is achieved by using XML and DXF file formats. The XML file can be accessed by any software that can open this file format. It is the basis of most autoCAD plugins. The DXF file is structured to provide information on the drawing itself, including the layers and guides. AutoCAD 2011 adds a number of tools to automate repetitive tasks. Autodesk developed a product called AutoCAD Line it is an object-oriented programming tool that can be used to automate common tasks like creating door frame or window frames. A programmer can create subroutines that automate tasks such as "Draw Door Frame" and include a template so that a designer can choose the material of the frame. The system is geared toward

building multi-family housing. In 2012, a new line of product was introduced that included full-fledged applications called Architectural apps such as AutoCAD Architecture and AutoCAD Civil 3D. These architectural applications allow users to create and manage construction drawings, and are particularly useful in building construction projects. Drawings can be converted into other formats such as PDF, PNG, or GIF. Availability AutoCAD is available as a perpetual license and for a subscription basis. Microsoft AutoCAD is available for Windows and also runs on Mac OS X, Linux, and Android OS. It is available in a few forms as described below.

Home and Student editions The AutoCAD Home and Student editions are very similar to the Professional edition with some notable differences. AutoCAD LT is the AutoCAD LT edition. It includes a limited number of features as compared to the AutoCAD Pro or Architectural editions. It is intended for schools, CAD Training Centers, and similar organizations. This version of AutoCAD is available with perpetual or a subscription-based licensing model. AutoCAD Student is the AutoCAD Student edition. This edition includes features that are used only for teaching purposes. AutoCAD Classic is the AutoCAD Classic edition. AutoCAD Classic does not include the features included in AutoCAD LT or AutoCAD. AutoCAD Classic is available with perpetual or a subscription-based licensing model. Markup Import makes it easy to import images from PDFs and printed papers. It can be used to quickly import tables, figures, logos, and other types of images in PDFs and printouts. You can import a mark from one drawing to another (import), or import an annotation from a PDF into a DWG (markup import). You can also combine these two features in a workflow (markup assist) that allows you to import a mark from one drawing to another, then annotate the imported mark by using the drawing tools. This feature also supports export to a PDF for printed document. Markup Assist provides 2 new templates: Text and Drawing Object. There are several changes to tools and commands in CAD including: Drawing the shape of curve or spline with just one click and the new drawing command: CREATE CURVE Two new visualization tools in the legend to track a sequence of objects using 3D visualizations. Updated the ribbon to be more responsive and user-friendly. Start/End Editing: CAD allows you to quickly enter edit/extend commands such as MOVE, COPY, and LOAD using the keyboard. Typing the commands will now open the command dialog with the appropriate insertion point active. You can also drag the insertion point onto a command to enter edit/extend commands. GIS: When you export an embedded layer from AutoCAD, it creates a layer that no longer contains

data. The tool Embed GIS Shape allows you to re-attach the shape to the data that it represents. 3D: You can now assign layer properties to 3D views as well as 2D views.
