Q: Powershell how to replace a Substring with a specific character I'm a beginner in Powershell I need to replace a specific string that contains a sub String with a specific character. Example: string text = "Hello World some text"  
string replaceWith = "Hello-World-some-text" The text i want to convert is the first String. The ReplaceWith is the sub-string i want to convert with a - symbol. Any suggestions?  
A: You could use the -replace operator. `$myString = "Hello World"`  
`$myString -replace "Hello ", "-World"` This will c6a93da74d
